Experimental features

BBC Radio is to make several experimental features which are to be broadcast in binaural stereo. The listener will need stereo headphones to receive these programmes, which, the BBC says "will give a totally new kind of sound."

One programme already made in this process is The Oil Rig, produced by Richard Imison, directed by Tony Simmons with sound recording by Leo Feord and Lloyd Silverthorne, It can be heard on Tuesday, February 8 on BBC Radio 3

Another experimental programme, produced by Desmond Briscoe, with sound recording by Geoffrey Purrier, is A Wall Walks Slowly: The Sound of Cumbria. This will be broadcast on February 13 on BBC Radio 3.
